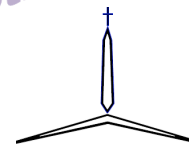

In 2022, we celebrated the Golden Jubilee of our Parish of St. Paul's, Lisduggan. For our year of celebration, we planned a number of events and projects. One particular idea, which had much support, was the possibility of erecting a Jubilee Clock as a legacy item to mark our Golden Jubilee.

This idea has persisted and has resulted in the formation of a Jubilee Clock Committee, who have identified a site in front of St. Paul's Church, a pivotal location which would make the clock visible on all approach roads, and have advanced a detailed design and plan for the installation, with proposed construction January - March 2026.

We are now at the stage of gathering resources and raising funds to meet the requirements of bringing this project to completion. We are appealing to you, for any help, financial or otherwise, in bringing this to fruition.

For the weekend of the 22nd of November we hope to circulate an envelope which you can use if you wish to make a donation to St. Paul's Jubilee Clock Fund.

PRAYERS FOR THE PRE-SYNODAL ASSEMBLY OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH IN IRELAND

All Catholics are invited to pray for a special
gathering that will take place in Kilkenny on 18
October, called a Pre-Synodal Assembly of the
Catholic Church in Ireland. This assembly is an
important juncture on the journey towards a
National Synodal Assembly to be held in
2026. Around 240 people will be in attendance
and these are drawn from each diocese on the
island, Religious Congregations and Church
movements. A preparatory document,
entitled *Baptised and Sent* - the fruits of
listening sessions across Ireland last spring -
will be the basis for discussion at this gathering,
and for the next stage of the journey of
renewal. Central to the document is a renewed
focus on baptism as the foundation of our
Christian dignity, unity, and mission and how
baptism infuses the life and mission of the
Church in Ireland today and into the future.
