PARISHES OF ST. PAUL'S & BUTLERSTOWN CHANGES TO OUR MASS SCHEDULE Beginning Thursday 14th of October

As we adapt to the impact of Fr. Sean's retirement, regretfully it will be necessary to make some changes to our weekly Mass Schedule. These changes were discussed and approved by the Parish Pastoral Council at its monthly meeting on Tuesday evening.

- As and from Thursday, October 14th our only Thursday morning Mass will be at 10.00 a.m. in Butlerstown, which will replace the current 9.15 a.m. Mass.
 This means there will not be a morning Mass in St. Paul's on
 - This means there **will not** be a morning Mass in St. Paul's on Thursdays.
- We will also discontinue the Saturday morning 10.00 a.m. Mass in St. Paul's. There will of course be the scheduled Saturday evening Mass at 6.00 p.m.

We hope that many of our community will be able to travel to Butlerstown on Thursday mornings for the 'new' 10.00am. Mass. We trust that the Live Streaming of the Mass will help those who cannot.

The New Mass Schedule is a follows:

Mass in Butlerstown Church at 10.00am: Thursday There will be no change to the Sunday schedule

St. Paul's: 6.00pm.(Vigil), 8.30am, 11.30 am.

Butlerstown: 10.00am.

REAL RICHES (MARK 10:17-30)

The preacher had placed a mirror at the end of the church. He asked everyone to look in it and at the edge of the mirror
