

Excerpt from Minutes of Lisduggan Development Association 10th September, 1969

"Fr. Power gave the revised prices from three contractors for the new Church:
John Hearne £101,579;
Jennings £108,000;
Murphy, Cork £109,000.
Three suggestions were put forward:

- 1. Build Church as specified;
- 2. Build a Church unfinished for £75,000;
- 3. Build Hall with Sanctuary.

A discussion took place as to the type of Church most suitable to our needs. Voting then took place, twenty-eight people present having a vote. Result: 19 votes in favour of Church; 9 votes in favour of Hall.

Fr. Power to make decision known to Parish Priest.
