LUKE 12:35-40 In this week's gospel we have A DE TRA CAL several sayings of Jesus on one general theme. This is not a logically

teaching, but a collection of sayings, each one different and with its own way of putting across the theme.

The sayings of Jesus are usually metaphors speaking to our imagination. All the sayings in this passage are about waiting.

Who are the people that Jesus sent into our lives to encourage us to wait with patience and not give up because these times can be a great blessing if entered into with a positive attitude?

Lord thank you for people who sit and wait with us and help us to realise that in waiting with patience we can often gain many insights into our lives which we are too busy to see.

Forgive us Lord for the times we felt that we become impatient and angry because we feel God is not answering our prayer quickly enough and we begin to panic instead of trusting that the Lord will never let us down.

Help us Lord to be aware that God is always at work in our lives and he is helping us to carry out his loving purpose for our lives, even in the times we do not see it. We are rushing about instead of waiting in loving expectation.
