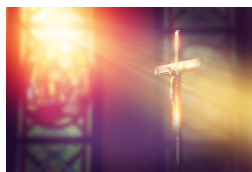

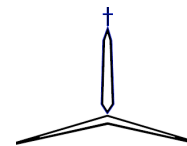

TRUST

"Whoever can be trusted with very little can also be trusted with much, and whoever is dishonest with very little will also be dishonest with much." (Luke 16:10)

It is clear from these words that Jesus did not approve of, nor did he excuse, dishonesty or unfaithfulness. If a person can be trusted in handling a matter of small importance, he can also be trusted with important matters; if he cannot be depended on in connection with the first, it would not be safe either to entrust to him the second.

Everything depends on the quality of the person. Jesus calls us to faithfulness in little things, because most of life is made up of small things. Few of us can save the world, but we can conduct honest business, tutor a child, visit a person in a nursing home, or help a neighbour in distress.
