SMALL GESTURES OF MERCY (Matthew 10:37-42)

The Gospel of Jesus is not only about a way of life founded on love and mercy, but above all about the person of Jesus himself. Today he claims a special place in our lives, more important than our dearest ones. Being a disciple is not a marginal aspect of our lives, it is central. We ask for the grace to be real disciples of Jesus.

At the same time, Jesus assures us that even the smallest gesture of mercy to those in need will not go unnoticed.

We help in simple ways with small gestures. This is what Pope Francis refers to in his encouragement of simple love,

'like the warm supper we look forward to at night, the early lunch awaiting someone who gets up early to go to work. Homely gestures.

Like a blessing before we go to bed, or a hug after we return from a hard day's work. Love is shown by little things, by attention to small daily signs which make us feel at home. Faith grows when it is lived and shaped by love' (Pope Francis September 2015).
