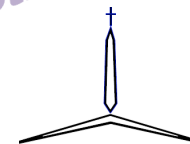

### *Loving Father,*

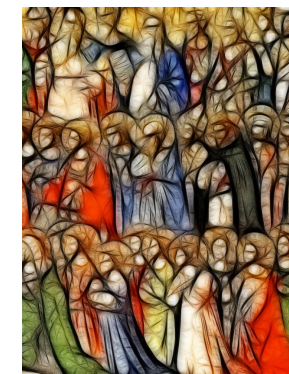
Open our hearts to hidden realities:
